We are currently accepting applications for the following summer positions:

<u>Summer Teen Camp Workers (2 Positions)</u> - Assist in planning and supporting teens attending Teen Summer Camp. Community Inclusion-Summer Children's Camp

<u>Quality Assurance Support (1 Position)</u> - This student will work alongside the Quality Assurance Coordinator in an office setting and assist with data input, training, ministry compliance, accreditation, and documentation.

<u>Adult Group Home Support Workers (4 Positions)</u> - These students will provide community- based recreational activities for adults who have a developmental disability. They will plan activities for and assist participants in these community-based activities.

<u>Children's Home Support Worker (1 Position)</u> - This student will assist children with a developmental disability, in a residential group home as they pursue interests, developmental or interpersonal skills, daily life tasks and community inclusion.

QUALIFICATIONS:

To qualify for the above-noted position applicants MUST be:

- Between the ages of 15 and 30;
- Registered as a full-time student for the previous academic year and intend to return to school in the fall;
- A Canadian citizen, permanent resident or a person on whom refugee status has been conferred;
- Not working at another full-time job; and
- Once you are identified as a candidate you must register and be screened at the Human Resources Centre of Canada for Students. You must pass the screening to be hired.

ADDITIONAL QUALIFICATIONS:

- Current First Aid and CPR;
- Police Clearance (Vulnerable Sector Search);
- Experience supporting people with developmental disabilities (Preferred)
- Valid G license and driver's abstract (For some positions)
