

SUMMER STUDENT(S) POSTING – ADULT GROUP HOME SUPPORT WORKER

We are currently accepting applications for the following summer position:

- 1. Summer Teen Camp Workers (2 Positions)- Assist in planning and supporting teens attending Teen Summer Camp.
- 2. Community Inclusion-Summer Children's Camp (2 Positions)
- 3. Adult Group Home Support Workers (2 Positions)- These students will provide community-based recreational activities for adults who have a developmental disability. They will plan activities for and assist participants in these community-based activities.
- 4. Community Participation (1 Position)
- 5. Children's Home Support Worker (1 Position)- This student will assist children in a residential group home with a developmental disability as they pursue leisure interests, developmental or interpersonal skills, daily life tasks, and community inclusion.
- 6. Day Program (1 Position)

Rate of Pay: The hourly rate of pay will be \$16.00 and the number of hours per week will be approximately 35.

Position Start Date and Term: To be discussed during the interview.

QUALIFICATIONS:

To qualify for the above-noted position applicants MUST be:

- Between the ages of 15 and 30 at the start of employment;
- Enrolled in or have completed a secondary or post-secondary diploma/degree program;
- A Canadian citizen, permanent resident or a person on whom refugee status has been conferred under the Immigration and Refugee Protection Act;
- Not working at another full-time job; and

• Once you are identified as a candidate you must register and be screened at the Human Resources Centre of Canada for Students. You must pass the screening to be hired.

ADDITIONAL QUALIFICATIONS:

- Current First Aid and CPR;
- Police Clearance (Vulnerable Sector Search);
- Experience supporting people with developmental disabilities; and
- Valid G license and driver's abstract
